#### **OCTOBER**

- Finish your personal statement.
- Begin college applications.
- Request transcripts via Xello.
- Start the FAFSA.

#### **NOVEMBER**

- Apply to 5+ colleges.
- Finish the FAFSA.



#### **DECEMBER**

- Submit all college applications.
- Begin researching scholarships.
- Start scholarship essay drafts.

#### **JANUARY**

- Identify 5 essay-based scholarships.
- Work on scholarship essay drafts.
- Check for college acceptances/denials.

#### **FEBRUARY**

- Work on scholarship essay drafts and applications.
- Check for college acceptances/denials.
- Activate college portal(s).

#### **MARCH**

- Work on scholarship essay drafts and applications.
- Check for college acceptances/denials.
- Review financial aid package(s).

#### **APRIL**

- Work on scholarship essay drafts and applications.
- Make an admissions decision.
- Determine methods of financing.
- Confirm housing plans.

#### MAY

- Check for scholarship offers.
- Make summer plans i.e. job, internship, or classes.
- Sign up for orientation with your college.
